

How often do students in year 7 study in Design & Technology?

Year 7 students have 4 lessons of Design & Technology per fortnight, usually 2 lessons each week.

What topics do you learn about in this Design & Technology in year 7?

In Design & Technology you will learn about investigating, designing, and making in 3 main material areas: **Graphics** (papers and boards), **Resistant Materials** (Woods, metals, and plastics) and **Textiles** (Fabrics and fashion). You will design and make you own prototypes in these lessons. You will also have a rotation of **Food Technology** where you will learn about practical cooking skills along with food nutritional information and basic health and hygiene.

What skills will you develop in this Design & Technology during year 7?

You will learn how to investigate and analyse existing products and develop drawing and designing skills to help you communicate your ideas in 2D and 3D. You will learn how to use tools and equipment in the workshops and food rooms independently, safely and with accuracy to enable you to create you own real life products and then evaluate your products to see how good they are and if you can improve them further in the future.

Do you need any specialist equipment to study Design & Technology?

The main equipment you will need is basic drawing equipment such as pens, pencils, pencil crayons and fine liners for designing tasks. A computer or laptop would be useful so you can complete home learning tasks.

What is the best thing about studying Design & Technology?

You can be creative and bring your designs and ideas into real life finished products!
